Academic Performance Scholarships

Regulations

The UOW College Hong Kong (UOWCHK) Academic Performance Scholarships are for students who are pursuing full-time self-financing associate degree and bachelor degree programmes. The regulations for these scholarships are as follows:

1. The Scholarships shall be known as the “UOWCHK Academic Performance Scholarships”.
2. There will be approximately one award per 100 students, up to a maximum of 20 awards. The value of each award shall be HK\$6,000. The maximum amount awarded shall be HK\$120,000.
3. The Scholarships are designated for covering part of the tuition fee of the recipient in Semester B of the academic year.
4. Eligibility:
Associate degree students – eligible applicants for the scholarship shall be students in their second year of study having attained an outstanding cumulative GPA of at least 3.40.
Bachelor degree students
Year 1 Entry - eligible applicants for the scholarship shall be students in their second year of study or above having attained an outstanding cumulative GPA of at least 3.40.
Year 3 Entry - eligible applicants for the scholarship shall be students in their fourth year of study having attained an outstanding cumulative GPA of at least 3.40.
5. The Programme Leaders of UOWCHK will be responsible for nominating suitable students for the Scholarships. The nominations shall be forwarded to Scholarship Coordinators of respective Faculties by end of January.
6. Students who have been awarded this scholarship before will not be nominated again in the same programme of study.
7. The Scholarships shall be offered annually until any notice of change is received from the UOWCHK.
